Senior Project Proposal

For my senior project, I will be taking a leadership position in the Laboratory Theatre Company, a student-run theatre company. Throughout the semester, I will be drafting different forms, running social media, creating and delegating a team, and overall completing the tasks that the Artistic Director of a company would have. I took on this role back in December and have been hard at work since, trying to book venues and preparing to put on a full production with a team of dedicated and passionate students. I'm hoping to use this time to gain some experience in running a legitimate theatre company and learn what it means to be an artistic director.

Over the next few months, I will be working closely with my team to put on the company's launch production, *Exit the King*.
