Description & Justification

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My Senior Project will be a writing project it will include 4 of my original poems, a three-part short story, and a video of an original two-part scene. The poems I will expect to write throughout the semester then get peer-reviewed and then I will edit one more time for the final draft. The three-part short story I will base on a prompt my professor gave me where I build solid characters then bring an action to them. The first part is from one perspective of the male main character and how he views this crisis. The second part is from the female's perspective and shows her thoughts. The third part will be a few months down the line when she wakes from her medically induced coma.

The original two-part scene will probably be the most challenging part because it challenges me to make a much larger project. I will eventually write an entire script that my friend and I are working on. These scenes will be a total of 15–20-minutes long. My plan for this script is to be about a woman going through life taking the ridicule of built-in images in other people's mindset of how she should be, but she chooses to do what makes her happy. I am titling this project *Unapologetically A Women* seeing that it will be about a young woman that is not sorry for her past decisions or presents ones. The scene I will be focusing on for this senior project is when a guy struggling to commit to a relationship comes over to the central character's place. This will occur after he had just found out something from her past from a co-worker at a bar, the

same bar he recently started managing for only about six months now. He had gone out drinking with his co-workers and is very upset about what they had to say about her and an act she committed on her 22<sup>nd</sup> birthday. The second scene will be about a woman who goes to the gym with her friend and encounters ex hookup. Here is where she witnesses him checking her out multiple yet never acknowledges her but dares to talk to several different women at the gym and eventually takes one home. She complains about him to her friend and when she realizes he decides to take someone how she confronts him and the girl with a massive outburst.

I am a creative writing minor and have taken poetry plus a few fiction short story classes. I started writing my poems and short stories for this project last semester and planned to edit and tighten them up for my senior project. Since I am writing this semester, I will pick which poems I want to choose closer to the end of the year for the chance that I could write one that I could be prouder of. For my short story, I will take what I am learning from my current class to go back in and clean up some details, but other than that, I finished this story at the end of last semester and am very proud of it.
